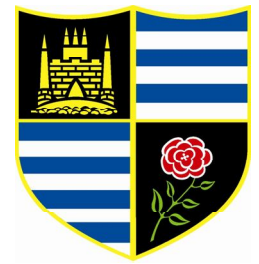

RESULTS FROM SATURDAY 3 SEPTEMBER

Ex 1st v Old Reigatian 2 L 12 - 29

Warlingham Ex1st (2nd XV) 12pts Old Reigatian 2s 29pts

Over the past two weeks Warlingham's 1st XV have beaten both Purley John Fisher (59 -21) and Effingham & Leatherhead - 18 - 10) in pre-season friendly games but were without a fixture on Saturday. This left their second string counterparts to start their pre-season warm-up. They hosted an experienced Old Reigatians side who had topped their league last season and were always going to be a tough test.

However Warlingham started brightly and had all of the possession and territory in the first quarter, culminating in an attacking scrum deep into the visitors half. No 8 talisman Ben Wiseman picked up from the base of the scrum and timed a perfect pass to speedy winger Jack Green who outpaced his opposite player for the first try. Centre Mark Kozminski's touchline kick was just wide. Reigatians were spurred into the attack and scrambled a try after strong forward play on the Warlingham line. The conversion was also missed. Warlingham skipper Richard Long led his forwards back into the Reigatian half and determined play by hooker Martin Pickett, scrum half Joe McEvoy and flanker Ben Freeman earned the hosts a penalty. Wiseman received the ball and, bouncing off several players, bulldozed his way over for a try. Kozminski added the conversion.

In the second half Reigatians settled into a routine and had far more possession and territory, enabling them to add their second try after spirited forward play. Warlingham came close when lock Luke Delderfield gave Wiseman a try-scoring pass but Wiseman was unable to complete the move when he knocked on in the tackle.

As the second half progressed, and Warlingham brought on several substitutes, Reigatians pressed home their superior fitness and, being a regular settled term, were able to put a further three tries on their hosts to run out worthy winners.

After the game Captain Richard Long said, "*We knew Reigatians would be a tough game but the lads performed well and we'll take a lot out of this game and improve for the league games ahead.*"

EPOS

Electronic Point of Sale tills have now been installed at the Club. This allows us to have greater control over prices charged, use of stock and re ordering process. It also allows us to offer members a discount on all there orders when they use their EPOS card. Cards will be issued to all members who have paid their subscriptions for the 2011/12 season. The card needs to be pre-loaded with money by either cash, cheque or credit card. Each round you buy after loading the card will be deducted from your credit and will give you 10% discount on all drinks (not tobacco or snacks). Junior cards cannot purchase alcohol. Family membership will be issued with two cards. There is a £1.00 set up fee and a £5.00 replacement fee if it is lost defaced or stolen. If stolen please advise the bar manager as soon as possible and that card will be taken off the system. The credit you have pre-loaded is recorded in the computer and not on the card.

There has been a delay in getting the cards to us in time for the season. When they do arrive anyone who has paid subs should have their card waiting behind the bar. The setup fee will be deducted when you first activate your card
