Warlingham 17 Charlton Park 19

Having won their league comprehensively last season Charlton Park arrived at Hamsey Green full of confidence and it was this attitude which carried them through the first half of the game. With several new players having their first outing with the first XV, Warlingham took a while to settle down and the visitors had much the better of the early exchanges with much pressure on the Warlingham line. An interception try from Warlingham centre Ben Wimble, returning from a long-time injury, was against the run of play and Mark Kozminski's conversion was true. Charlton Park responded with vigor and immediately swept back down the pitch to score a converted try. Buoyed by the score Charlton Park then forced a five metre scrum from which Luke Boyns, their No 8, charged over for an unconverted try. After several unsuccessful penalty shots, the normally metronomic Kozminski converted one to close the gap. New Warlingham forwards Mike Fair and Gareth Morgan showed promise and full back Alex Skinner was safe as houses under the high ball. But there was no further score until after the break.

Immediately after the turn round the visitors outside half, Jake Smith weaved a delicious dance around the cover defence in the Warlingham 22 to score under the posts which he converted. In the last third of the game Warlingham's fitness counted and several breaks from captain James Agate and Jon Osborn put the pressure on their opponents and both Wimble and winger Jack Atkinson were unlucky not to breach the desperate Charlton Park defence. With further penalty misses and a knock on over the visitor's tryline it seemed Warlingham were destined not to score. However, a quickly taken penalty found the ball with Dan Street who was totally unstoppable from fifteen metres out. Scrum half Ollie Doe added the conversion to put Warlingham just two points adrift. Agate and Osborn linked well again to pressurise Charlton Park who contrived to be penalised numerous times by the referee Matthew Shales but no yellow card was shown. Late in the game long range penalty attempts from both Doe and Agate went wide and Charlton Park hung on desperately to take their first league win points.

After the game the Warlingham Head Coach, Tom Street, said: "This was a very disappointing result as we battled hard throughout the 80 minutes. Our fitness held us in good stead and, with the rub of the green, we could have won this encounter."

Next Saturday Warlingham make the shortest of away trips to neighbours Old Midwives.
